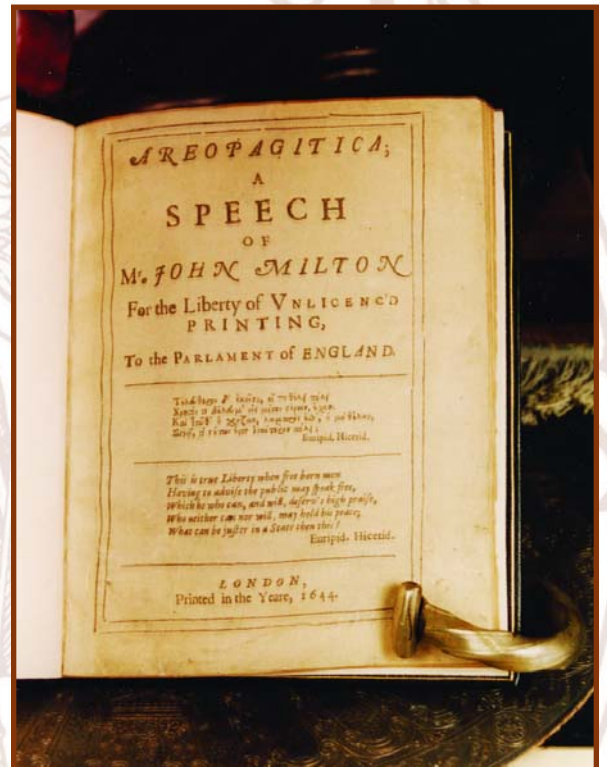

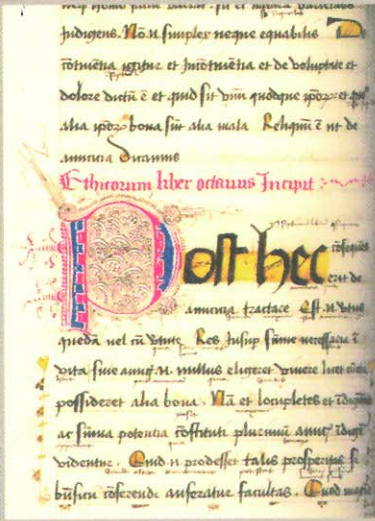

paper, 1496

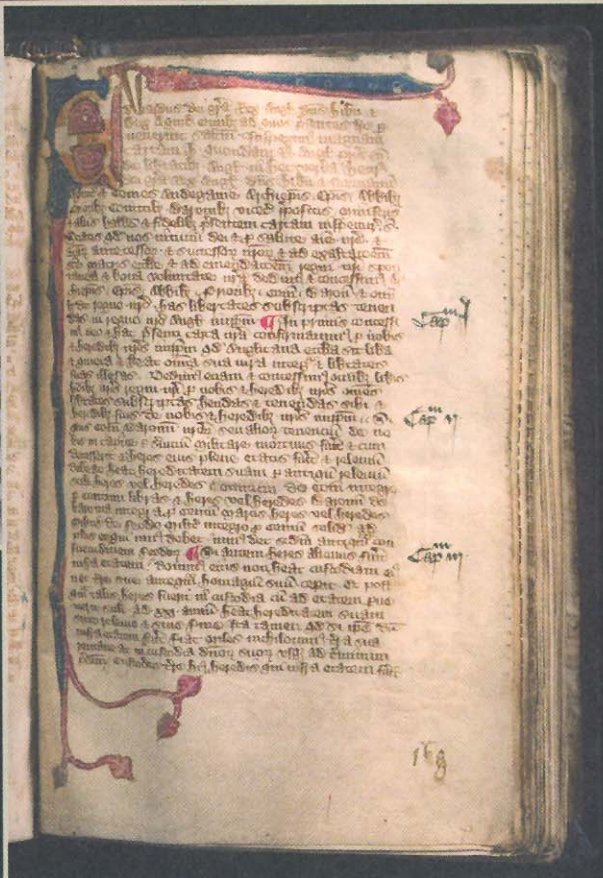


WORLD-CLASS COLLECTION IS SHARED.
