Trine hosts collection of rare books through May

Rare books and manuscripts focused on human dignity and individual freedoms will be displayed at Trine University starting Sunday.

The Remnant Trust collection includes a Gutenberg Bible leaf from 1455, Abraham Lincoln's Gettysburg Address from 1863, a 16th-century Hebrew Torah and "The Origin of Species by Means of Natural Selection" by Charles Darwin published in 1883.

Trine President Earl D. Brooks tells The Herald Republican (<http://bit.ly/1a5Rilk>) many professors are using the collection to enhance their studies.

The Winona Lake-based trust is encouraging visitors to hold the books and look through them even though they are rare. Founder Brian Bex believed such works were meant to be read and held.

Trine will have a collection on loan from the trust through May.
